

Scandinavian Seniors Open Amateur Championship

PGA Sweden National, Links Course, 30 July – 1 August 2020

The Championship will be played in accordance with the current editions of:

- R&A Rules of Golf Limited
- [Spel- och tävlingshandboken 1–3](#) (only in Swedish)
- [Swedish Golf Federation Rules Card](#) (Note: p.11 Section A is not applicable)
- [Temporary Additional Terms of Competition due to Covid-19](#) (only in Swedish)
- Terms of competition below and Local Rules and any additional Terms of Competition and Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

Terms of competition

1. Eligibility

Participants must

- be male and an amateur golfer in accordance with the Rules.
- have a maximum handicap (at the closing time of entry) 9.9
- be members of a Golf Club or a National Golf Union, Federation or Association.

2. Entry requirements

Entry

Last day to enter is 20 July 2020. Players who are members of a Swedish Golf Club should enter through Min Golf and international players can enter through the entry form found on scandinavianseniors.se. Entries can also be submitted through each players' national golf union on the players' behalf. Entrants are responsible for having their correct handicap registered at the closing time of entry. An entrant taking a place in the tournament on an incorrect handicap may be replaced by another entrant from the waiting list. Players are responsible to check if their entry has been accepted. Any claims must be submitted within 24 hours of the publishing of the list of participants.

Entry fee

Entry fee is €150. Entry fee shall be paid upon registration at the golf club, see time limits under Registration deadline below. Entry fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out.

Entries exceeding the maximum number accepted

In case of entries exceeding the maximum number of players accepted in the competition (156), entrants with the lowest handicap (at the closing time of entry) will be accepted.

Cancellation of entries

Accepted players not cancelled by 22 July 12:00 pm are requested to pay the entry fee in full.

Registration deadline

Registration and payment of the entry fee must be made at the front desk of the golf club at the latest on Wednesday 29 July 6.00 pm (18:00).

Players who cannot register and pay the entry fee in person by the registration deadline, must contact the tournament committee, before the deadline, to confirm their participation. Failure to do so may result in the tournament committee replacing the player with another player from the waiting list.

3. Format

54 holes Individual Stroke Play. A maximum of 156 players will play 18 holes each day on 30 and 31 July. The 70 best results and ties make the cut and will play a final round over 18 holes on 1 August. The competitor with the lowest aggregate score will be the champion. A minimum of 18 holes must be completed by all competitors to attain a result.

4. Decisions of ties

In the event of a tie for the first position, the champion shall be decided by a hole by hole play-off on the holes previously indicated by the Championship Committee. All other tied positions will be resolved by using the method of count back for the last 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 and last hole in that order.

5. Miscellaneous

Practice

Practice day is Wednesday 29 July - each player is allowed one practice round within the entry fee.

Transportation

Point 11 in Section A – Local Rules on the Swedish Golf Federation Rules Card is NOT applicable and golf carts will be permitted. There will be a limited number of golf carts available and they will be booked at first come first served basis.

Trophies

Trophies will be awarded the top three scratch results.
